About Vision: (of the Institution)

A big picture idea of what the Institution wants to achieve over a period of time.

The vision is the dream of the Institution. It is about the future of the Institution. It is what the Institution believes concerning ideal conditions. It is what how things would look if the issue important to the Institution were completely perfectly addressed.

At present a goal for the Institution is to achieve the highest level of accreditation, namely A++, and subsequently autonomy; then press forwards with the dream of realizing one of the goals set by the National Education Policy, (NEP). This goal is to rise higher in standards so as to transform the Institution to a University, as NEP anticipates

Given this dream, how can the vision statement be made?

It may well be articulated by one or more *vision statements* which are short phrases or statements that convey the Institution's hopes for the future.

About Mission. (of the Institution)

The vision statement should inspire people to dream. The mission statement should inspire them to action.

The mission statement describes what the Institution is going to do, (action), and why it is going to do that.

The mission statement is more concrete and action-oriented.

The mission statement might refer to a problem. The mission statements hint at how the Institution might fix the problem or reach the goal.

Mission statements are: (i) <u>concise</u>, i.e. they get their point across in one sentence (ii) <u>outcomeoriented</u>; they explain the fundamental outcomes the Institution is working to achieve (iii) <u>inclusive</u>; mission statement tell about Institution's key goals broadly: good mission statements are not limiting in their strategies.
