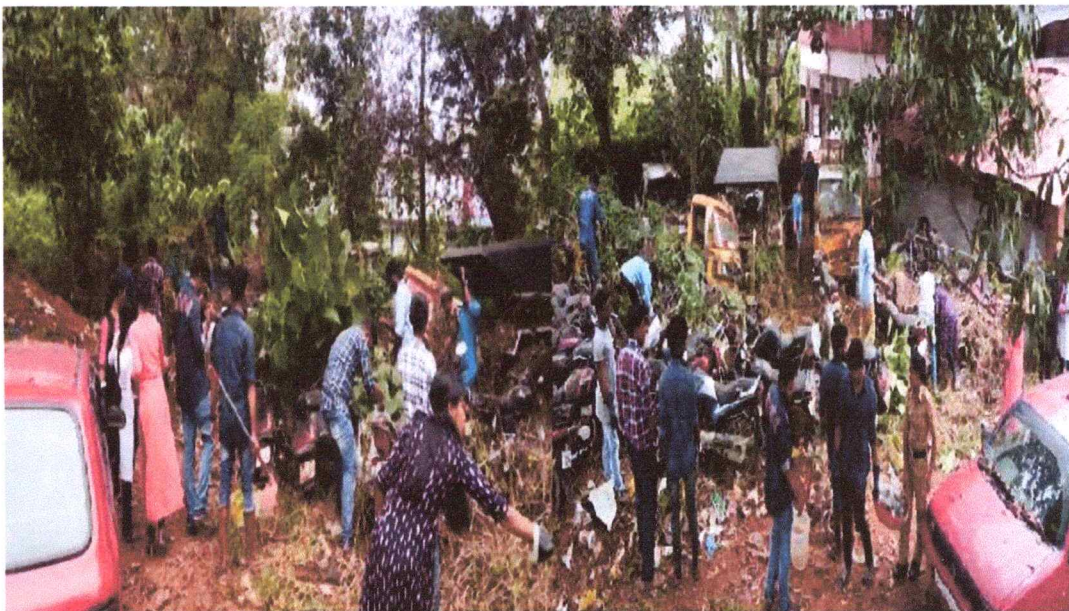

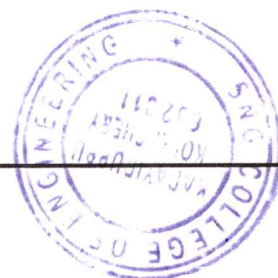
Title	Plastic Removal from Roads

As a part of the NSS activities of SNGCE, the students of SNGCE conducted plastic removal from roads program in Kadayiruppu on 07-12-21. Removing plastic from roads is an important step towards reducing environmental pollution and promoting sustainability. While plastic waste on roads can be unsightly, it can also pose hazards to wildlife and ecosystems. Manual cleaning involves physically picking up the plastic debris from the road surface. This method is effective for larger plastic items but time-consuming. Plastic Removal can be achieved by promoting recycling, reducing single-use plastic consumption, and implementing effective waste management strategies at the community and governmental levels.

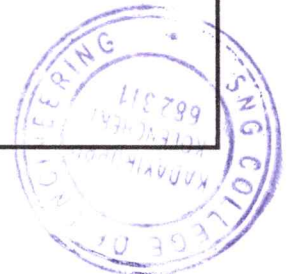


Title	Awareness Programme on Plastic Free Environment
