The Department of Science and Humanities organised a talk on Constitution of India. The session was handled by Dr. Jacob Joseph, Director, Centre for Law and Agriculture on March 6th 2023. The **Constitution of India** is the supreme law of India. Roy . It is the longest written national constitution in the world. 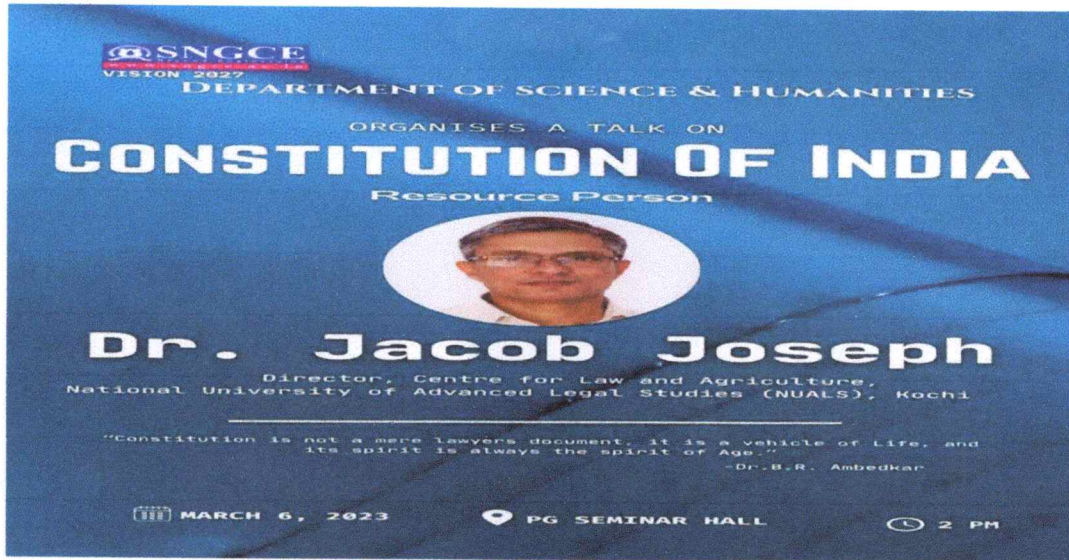
