

8. Amenities such as canteen, store, transport, playgrounds etc.


9. Sufficient furniture are distributed to all the departments for both staff and students.



Students Activity Body	A Staff advisor is nominated by the principal to coordinate all activities of the College Students' Council. The aim is to give orientation and leadership among students by organizing various extra-curricular activities. The council consists of representatives elected from all classes. Two representatives from classes having more than 35 students are elected. The term in office of the elected representatives is normally be one year. Students with sound academic and good attendance record are only eligible to contest for election. In addition, the Principal may nominate up to four representatives from students who are proficient in arts, sports, literary talents, etc., if not, properly represented by election. Under representation of girl students and non representation from SC/ST communities will also be taken in to account for such nomination. Office bearers of the students' council such as Chairperson, General Secretary, Sports /Arts Secretary, Magazine Student Editor, University Union Councilors (one or two based on student strength), etc. are elected by the representatives.
Cultural activities	Cultural activity coordinator prepares the budget in consultation with the Staff adviser, for hosting cultural events within the campus. Cultural activity coordinator forms teams of staff and students to handle various responsibilities for conducting arts festival in the college. Frequent interactions and rehearsals are conducted by delegating responsibilities. Screening of likely participants is arranged to enable minimum standard during competitions. Competitions are held among the students department-wise and talents are identified. Cultural events are conducted in line with the scheduled itinerary and winners are awarded prizes during a ceremonial function. Students are also sent to other inter collegiate competitions, accompanied by the cultural activity coordinator or other staff, with the approval of Principal.
Sports activities	Physical education lecturer prepares the calendar for the sports and games activities. He arranges the preparation of the facilities, procurement of the kit and organizes regular practice by selected participants. He also organizes teams of staff and students to handle various responsibilities for conducting the sports and games in the College. The students are divided in to four houses and a staff in-charge is appointed for each. Each house selects a captain. The sports and games are conducted in line with the scheduled itinerary and the winners are awarded prizes. Physical education lecturer maintains a list of talented sportsperson based on earlier performances within and outside the college. As and when inter-collegiate/inter university sports and games activities are announced, the Principal directs the Physical education lecturer to initiate necessary actions who in turn selects the team and arranges for the necessary applications to the organizers in consultation and approval of the Principal.

Magazine / Newsletter	College magazine is generally brought out every year to bring forth hidden literary talents of students. It can include contributions from staff and students like general articles, technical papers, poems, jokes, drawings, etc. It may contain messages from dignitaries who are well wishers of the College. The Principal appoints a staff editor for the publishing of the college magazine, who in turn constitutes an editorial board with staff/student representatives. Student editor, elected by the Students' council assists in bringing out the magazine. The magazine may highlight various departmental activities in the academic year, photographs of final year students, annual report by the Principal, brief reports on sports and cultural activities of students along with photographs, academic achievements of students and such other important activities of the year. The list of contributions to be published shall be decided by the editorial board. The Principal approves the same before printing. The magazine is usually released in a function arranged by the College. <b>News Letters:</b> The Principal appoints a news letter editor for the publishing of the college news letters periodically. Activities within the quarter are usually reported in news letters. Forth coming activities are also highlighted in the news letter. The news letter is usually circulated to neighbouring colleges and well wishers.
